## **CONTEST RULES & PRIZE INFORMATION**

Thank you for participating! You are creating an original work of art to be featured in the new Economics Concepts Poster Series at Purdue University's business school.

Participants must create an entry on an 8.5 x 11-inch sheet of unlined, white paper. All entries must be accompanied by an entry form. Entry forms can be downloaded from the Purdue Center for Economic Education (PCEE) website.

All entry forms must be signed by the entrant's parent/guardian. By signing, parents grant permission for their children's artwork, first name, school, and hometown to be shared online and used for printing notecards, posters, and calendars for free distribution to Indiana classrooms and/or sale to the public.

Only one entry per person is allowed. Entry and entry form due by March 3, 2025.

#### **ENTER ONLINE**

Participants who enter online must keep their original artwork. Any finalists who entered online will be required to send in the original entry.

### **JUDGING**

After the submission period has passed, PCEE's official panel of judges will select a first-, second-, and third- place winner for each of three categories:

- K-3 grades (or ages 5-8 at the time of entry if homeschooled)
- 4-6 grades (or ages 9-12 at the time of entry if homeschooled)
- 7-12 grades
   (or ages 13-19 at the time of entry if homeschooled)

Officers, directors, and employees of PCEE and the immediate family members of and/or people living in the same household as any such officers, board members, directors, or employees are NOT eligible to enter the contest or win a prize. This contest is void where prohibited.

# **PRIZES**

Winners will have their art featured in the new Economics Concepts Poster Series to be published by PCEE in 2025 and/or included on notecards, calendars, mugs, t-shirts and other items. These items will be made available for sale by PCEE to support programming. In addition, PCEE will make a grant to the classroom teacher listed on the entrant's entry form. Please note that grants cannot be made to homeschool entries.
