REQUIREMENTS

- NMIMS students will complete 63 credits in their first year of their MBA program in India. Upon arrival at Purdue, students must complete 32 graduate credit hours.
- Must have an average Plan of Study GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Applicants must have received a grade of 'B' in both courses to be transferred from NMIMS to be considered for admission.
- Applicants must submit the standard online applications to Purdue's Office of Graduate Students and Postdoctoral Scholars.
- After Purdue admission, students will be subject to immigration and fee(s) requirements to obtain their U.S. student visa according to the standards and procedures of Purdue's Office of International Students and Scholars (ISS). Students will be responsible for arranging their U.S. visa applications and covering any associated costs and fees.
